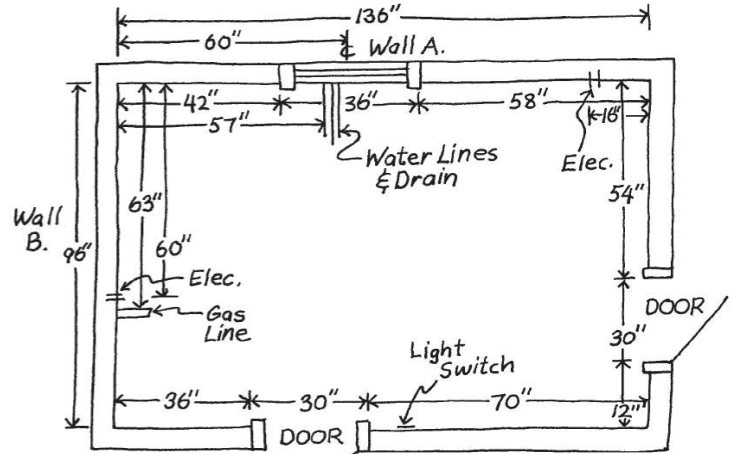


## DO-IT Yourself Kitchen Floor Plan Grid


- Start measuring with the first wall on the left and work your way to the right around the room. Measure the overall length of each wall and then record them on the grid along with the drawing of the room.

- Indicate all objects and breaks on the wall (windows, doors, panel boxes, vents, etc...) by measuring from the left corner of the wall to the edge of the object and include the width of the object. Continue this process around the room.

Note the location of your plumbing fixtures, gas lines, and electrical outlets. You may be able to move appliances several inches either way to accommodate a layout change.



Example Floor Plan



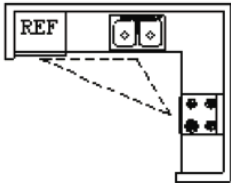
A large grid for recording measurements and drawing the floor plan. The grid is 30 squares wide and 30 squares high.

1 Square = 1 Foot

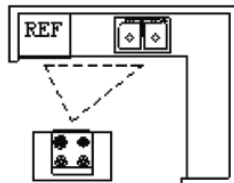

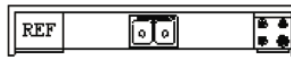
### Your Kitchen Shape



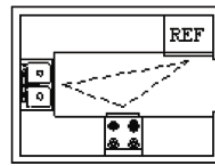
“L” Shaped



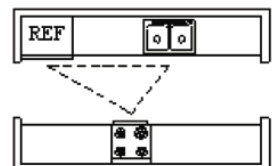
“L” Shaped w/ Island
